INVESTIGATIVE REPORT

Witness II

This investigative report documents the recorded, sworn interview of [REDACTED]. The interview was conducted in furtherance of the investigation into the February 26, 2012, shooting death of Trayvon Martin.

[REDACTED] is a resident of the Retreat at Twin Lakes and currently resides at [REDACTED] Twin Trees Lane, Sanford, Florida. Event details of the foregoing investigation indicate a 911 call was received from this address, listing the caller as [REDACTED].

On March 19, 2012, at approximately 1335 hours, Special Agent (SA) John Batchelor along with Investigator Jim Post of the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit conducted a recorded, sworn interview with [REDACTED] at her residence.

The following is a summary of this same interview and is not meant to be all-inclusive.

[REDACTED] was provided a copy of a sworn written statement, that she gave to members of the Sanford Police Department on the evening of February 26, 2012. [REDACTED] verified the written statement as being the one she authored and provided to the Sanford Police Department.

[REDACTED] said they (referring to her and her fiancé [REDACTED]) were watching television with the back door open, because it was rainy and relaxing. She then heard someone yelling or talking loud, maybe two or three guys or even a group of guys. As she muted the television the talking stopped and she heard more of a "scuffling" across the grass and pavement sound. Because of previous issues with "break-ins" she called 911. As she was on the phone with 911 she heard yelling, which turns into the word "help", which she heard approximately fifteen (15) times. [REDACTED] goes into the kitchen where she heard a gun shot. [REDACTED] said the yelling then stopped, at which time they immediately went upstairs. [REDACTED] said she did not see anything.

[REDACTED] was asked about her involvement with the Neighborhood Watch Program.

[REDACTED] a Home Owners Association (HOA) board member, said that she was not present at the meeting held on September 22, 2012, during which the Sanford Police Department put on a presentation about the neighborhood watch program. Although not in attendance, [REDACTED] said

that she was aware George Zimmerman had been nominated to a leadership position within the neighborhood watch program. [REDACTED] said that Zimmerman had attended prior meetings where there was discussion about previous "break-ins" and what to do about preventing them. Once the neighborhood watch program was established, [REDACTED] said that Zimmerman did attend subsequent HOA meetings.
